The list of qualified candidates for admission in Shikshashastra (B.Ed.) through NTA CUET-PG Entrance Test – 2023 is uploaded on the website of the University. Accordingly, the successful candidates of CUET are informed to report online for counselling/Admission on 29th and 31st August, 2023 from 10.00am through the link (Google Meet Platform) provided on WhatsApp group by the Faculty members of the School of Education.

Shiksha Shastri (B.Ed.) Course.

The qualified eligible candidates who have called by the University for Counselling as per schedule are directed to show original documents in support of their eligibility criteria & reservation if any, to seek admission in Shiksha Shastri (B.Ed.) course.


At the beginning, the candidates are to produce/show all the relevant original documents to the admission committee. Those candidates who fail to produce/show necessary documents/testimonials in original and not attend the counselling shall not be admitted in their respective course at any circumstances. The candidates who are recommended by the admission committee are required to deposit their fee through online from 29.08.2023 onwards through the provided link on their email.

The list of qualified candidates is provisional in nature and the University reserves the right for change after the verification of documents at any stage.

The list of qualified candidates is prepared based on the information furnished by the candidate at the time of the submission of online application form. In case any information found incorrect, the onus will exclusively be on the part of the candidate. The University will not be responsible for wrong information, if any, furnished by the candidate.

Any misleading information with regards to eligibility, category or otherwise mentioned in the application/admission form and detected at any stage by the University shall lead to cancellation of admission forthwith and in such cases refund of admission fees and other remittances shall be allowed as per the rule of the University.

The waiting list will be displayed on the University website subject to the availability of seats.
