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Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Centre (MMTTC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi under UGC, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India (formerly Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) under Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers & Teaching (PMMMNMTT) scheme) was inaugurated by Hon'ble Chairman of UGC Prof. M. Jagdesh Kumar. The vision of this centre is to develop skills & competencies in the higher education faculty members for better teaching, learning and research in line with NEP 2020. This Centre as TLC has successfully organized 64 programmes. This Centre has also conducted 03 Annual Refresher Programme In Teaching (ARPIT) courses through SWAYAM in Sanskrit discipline and has published 02 handbooks for teaching Sanskrit. Our MMTTC since its inception in September 2023 has successfully organized 31 programmes viz. 05 One Week Faculty Development Programme (04 in online and 01 in offline mode), 01 One Month Mandatory Faculty Induction Programme (online mode), 04 Two Weeks Refresher Course (online mode) and 21 Eight Days NEP Orientation & Sensitization programmes till now.

Backerep

The current educational landscape is marked by significant paradigm shifts viz. from Quantity to Quality, from Teaching to Learning, from Teacher centric to Student centric approaches, from Summative to Formative assessment, from Objectives to Outcomes etc. These shifts are addressed through various qualitative initiatives taken by UGC in the form of academic & evaluation reforms for Higher Education Institutions. One such qualitative reform is Outcome Based Education (OBE) which is a result-oriented approach to education that focuses & organises the entire educational program & instructional effects around the clearly defined 'outcomes' articulated at programme, programme specific, course levels. In other words, this approach focuses on measuring student performances through Outcomes expressed in terms of knowledge, understanding, skills, abilities & attitude attained at end of any learning experiences. In line with this approach the UGC has developed Learning Outcomes based Curriculum Framework (LOCF) for UG & PG levels. In addition to that various frameworks such as National Credit Framework (NCF), National Higher Education Qualifications Framework (NHEQF), National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF), National School Education Qualification Framework (NSEQF) etc. have also been developed for ensuring the smooth & effective implementation of OBE. Apart from that the assessment & accreditation process of HEIs by NAAC also lays stress on OBE. Thus, it becomes pertinent for every Higher Education Faculty to have the understanding of this approach which will pave the way for its effective planning, designing, implementation & execution. In this backdrop, a one week online national FDP has been organised with an intent to give insight into the OBE approach & various frameworks thereby developing competencies for their effective implementation.

Gbjective

The objectives of this programme are:

- to acquaint with the concept of Outcome Based Education (OBE) & various frameworks.
- to give insight into the basic terms implied in OBE viz. Programme Outcomes (POs), Programme Specific Outcomes (PSOs), Course Outcomes (COs), Graduate Attributes, Program Indicators, Choice Based Credit System (CBCS), Credit Level & Point etc.
- to develop skills for formulating outcomes at Programme and Course levels in line with Blooms Taxonomy.
- to provide insight in various Frameworks viz. NCF, NHEQF, NSQF, NSEQF etc.

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- Higher Education faculty members of all disciplines working in universities and colleges (from Assistant Professor to Professors, lecturers etc.)
- Teacher Educators from both traditional and modern universities.
