About TLC

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi established in 2017 under Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers & Teaching (PMMMNMTT) scheme is now being renamed as Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Centre (MMTTC) by UGC, Ministry of Education to sought a synergy and integration between HRDCs and PMMMNMTT Centres. The vision of this centre is to develop skills & competencies in the higher education faculty members for better teaching, learning and research in line with NEP 2020. The TLC of our university since its inception had successfully organized 60 programmes in the form of workshops, seminars, conferences & training programmes and 04 one month mandatory Faculty Induction Programme (FIP) for newly inducted Higher Education Faculty from which more than 7000 participants were benefitted. The Centre had also conducted 03 Annual Refresher Programme In **Teaching**(ARPIT)coursesthroughSWAYAMinSanskritdisciplineandhadalsopublished02 handbooks for teaching Sanskrit one at upper primary level and other at secondary level. This Centre has now been identified as one of the Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Centre which was inaugurated by Hon'ble Chairman of UGC Prof. M. Jagdesh Kumar. The Centre has successfully organized **10** NEP Orientation & Sensitization programmes till now.
