This Centre as TLC has successfully organized **64 programmes**, conducted **03 Annual Refresher Programme In Teaching (ARPIT)** courses through SWAYAM in Sanskrit discipline and has published **02 handbooks** for teaching Sanskrit. Our MMTTC since its inception in September 2023 has successfully organized **66 programmes** viz. **12** One Week Faculty Development Programme, **04** One Month Mandatory Faculty Induction Programme, **09** Two Weeks Refresher Cours and **41** Eight Days NEP Orientation & Sensitization programmes till now.

Moreover, the increasing availability of digital resources, advance analytical tools, interdisciplinary approaches and emerging trends, has created new opportunities as well as new challenges for conducting research. Thus, understanding of research methodologies and proficiency in key research activities become pertinent for conducting systematic, scientific, relevant and impactful research. In this backdrop, two weeks Refresher Course has been organised with an intent to enhance skills and competencies related to appropriate use of various methodologies, tools and emerging trends in research.

- to strengthens conceptual understanding of key terms and steps of research process.
- to develop competencies for intelligent use of digital & AI tools in research work.
- to provide insight into emerging trends in research viz. interdisciplinary, multidisciplinary, innovative etc.

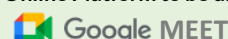
