About

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi was established in the component of Centres of Excellence for Curriculum and Pedagogy under **Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers & Teaching (PMMNMTT) scheme of Ministry of Education, Government of India**. This scheme was launched with an intent to improve quality in educational development at all stages of education. The vision of the centre is to develop skills and competencies of teachers and teacher educators associated with language education especially Sanskrit for designing, developing, implementing and evaluating teaching-learning systems. **The centre has been identified in the list of 30 new centres (IInd phase) for conducting one month mandatory Faculty Induction Programme (FIP) for newly inducted higher education faculty and also notified as National Resource Centre (NRC) for developing online Annual Refresher Programme in Teaching (ARPIT-2018, 2019 & 2020 courses) through SWAYAM in the discipline Sanskrit by Department of Higher Education of Ministry of Education, GOI. In addition to this, the centre has published two handbooks for teaching Sanskrit one at upper primary level and other at secondary level. The centre has successfully organized 39 programmes and 03 Faculty Induction Programmes (FIP) till now. All the programmes in phase-V will be conducted under patronship of hon'ble Vice Chancellor.**



Backdrop

In the current educational scenario due to rapid knowledge explosion, technology has become the integral part of not only of our day-to-day life but also of our educational system. Consequently, a critical need for having knowledge & competencies for use & integration of technology arises in all educational processes at all levels. Google plays a significant role in this regard by enhancing efficiency, productivity & effectiveness of teachers & students. Google apps for education are considered to be one of the best tools for communication, collaboration, documentation, storage, interactive learning and online teaching. They are web-based messaging and collaboration applications which are provided as a service rather than a software to download & install. Since these apps have transformed the ways for accessing information & knowledge anytime and from anywhere hence it becomes pertinent to have their knowledge & skills for using them. In this backdrop, one week Faculty Development Workshop has been organized with an intent to upgrade knowledge and competencies related to use, integration & application of Google tools in educational processes.



Objectives

The objectives of this workshop are:

- to familiarise with the basic function of google tools viz. drive, docs, sheet, forms, calendar, keep, meet, classroom, podcast etc.
- to give insight in the process of using & integrating various google tools in educational process.
- to enhance skills & competencies of using & applying various google tools.
