About TLC

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi was established in the component of Centres of Excellence for Curriculum and Pedagogy under **Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers & Teaching (PMMNMTT) scheme of Ministry of Education, Government of India**. The vision of the centre is to develop skills and competencies of teachers and teacher educators associated with language education especially Sanskrit for designing, developing, implementing and evaluating teaching-learning systems. The centre has been identified in the list of 30 new centres (IIInd phase) for conducting **one month mandatory Faculty Induction Programme (FIP) for newly inducted higher education faculty** and **also notified as National Resource Centre (NRC) for developing & conducting online Annual Refresher Programme In Teaching (ARPIT-2018, 2019 & 2020 courses) through SWAYAM in the discipline Sanskrit by Department of Higher Education of Ministry of Education, GOI**. In addition to this, the centre has **published two handbooks for teaching Sanskrit** one at upper primary level and other at secondary level. The centre has successfully **organized 50 programmes** and **03 Faculty Induction Programmes (FIP)** till now.

Backdrop

The role of assessment is of paramount importance for knowing the academic achievements, amount of learning, gaps in learning, strengths & weaknesses and for reviewing & monitoring any programme or process in any educational setting. This learning may belong to cognitive, affective and or psychomotor domains of an individual. Thus, assessment provides a systematic basis for making inferences about the learning & development of learning on one hand & whether or not the objectives are achieved on the other. To have such inferences various types of assessment tests are required as per the nature & objective of the intended information. So one must have the knowledge & skills of developing these tests in order to ensure the right assessment at the right time which will lead one step towards quality assessment. In this backdrop, a one week national FDP is organised with an intent to enhance the competencies & skills related to designing & developing various types of assessment tests.

Objectives

The objectives of this programme are:

- to familiarise with the various approaches & types of assessment & their tests.
- to give insight in the process of designing & developing assessment tests viz. Formative, Summative, NRT, CRT, Achievement, Performance, Diagnostic, Portfolio etc.
- to develop skill of preparing blue print for a test.
- to promote the skills related to developing various types of tests for assessment.

- Teacher Educators from both traditional and modern universities.
- Sanskrit school teachers only PGT or TGT.
- Research scholars from All Discipline.
