

**Phase-V, Programme-01**  
**03 Days Online National Workshop on**  
**Video Development & Editing**  
**From 19<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> May, 2021**

**Brief Report**

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi established under the scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India organized 03 Days Online National Workshop on Video Development & Editing from 19<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> May, 2021 which is the 1st programme of Phase-V. The objectives of this workshop were to give insight & enhance competencies related to the process and various ways of developing & editing videos. This online workshop was conducted through Google Meet platform. The inaugural session commenced with the welcome speech and backdrop note by the Director of the Centre, **Prof. Amita Pandey Bhardwaj** followed by Presidential address of Hon'ble *Vice Chancellor of our University*, **Prof. Ramesh Kumar Pandey** and vote of thanks by **Prof. Rajni Joshi Chaudhary (Dean & Head, School of Education)**. The workshop was transacted through 20 distinctly designed sessions comprising inaugural, induction, demonstration based 08 technical sessions, 03 Question & Answer sessions, 03 self-practice sessions, online assessment, feedback, sharing of experiences and valedictory sessions. **The registrations received till last date were 90 and the same continued the programme successfully.** Out of 90 participants 70 were from 18 states and 20 from 02 UTs. The number of participants from 18 states were Andhra Pradesh (03), Assam (01), Bihar (03), Chhattisgarh (02), Gujarat (04), Haryana (05), Himachal Pradesh (01), Jharkhand (02), Karnataka (02), Kerala (01), Maharashtra (15), Odisha (03), Punjab (01), Rajasthan (05), Tamil Nadu (03), Uttarakhand (03), Uttar Pradesh (13) & West Bengal (03) and from two UTs were Delhi (19) & J&K (01). All the technical sessions were conducted under the able guidance of **05 Resource Persons** having expertise in the concerned area from various reputed institutions of the Country. The main themes covered in the workshop were- Basics of Video Recording and Editing, Video Animation through PowToon, PPT based e-Content Development, Innovative Methods for Creating Interactive Videos, Video Recording & Editing through Filmora & VSDC and Screen Capturing Tools for Video Making. The participants were assigned choice based **05** assignments on the basis of the themes taken-up in the technical sessions. An **online test** was administered where 54% of the participants scored above 60%. In order to ensure the quality of the lectures delivered from participant's point of view an **online feedback about the Resource Persons** was taken in 04 categories viz. **Outstanding, Very good, Good & Satisfactory** and the average found was **77%, 17%, 05% & 01%** in the respective categories. In addition to this, **online feedback about the workshop** was also taken on 10 points in five categories and the average percentage was found to be **76% Excellent, 20% Very good, 04% Good, 00% Satisfactory and 00% Unsatisfactory.** In the valedictory session, the Director of the Centre welcomed the guests and presented the workshop outcomes followed by Chief Guest address by **Prof. R. P. Tiwari** (Vice Chancellor, Central University of Punjab, Bathinda) and presidential address of our *hon'ble Vice Chancellor Prof. Ramesh Kumar Pandey*, SLBSNS University. The workshop ended with vote of thanks and Shanti Path. After the completion of the workshop, the e-Certificate and e-Photo album were mailed to the successful participants.
