Phase-V, Programme-03 05 Days Online National Workshop on

Open Educational Resources (OERs)

Brief Report

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi established under the scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India organized 05 Days Online National Workshop on Development & Application of Open Educational Resources (OERs) from 14th to 18th June, 2021 which is the 3rd programme of Phase-V. The objectives of this workshop were to give insight & to promote competencies related to development & application of Open Educational Resources. This online workshop was conducted through Google Meet platform. The inaugural session commenced with the welcome speech and backdrop note by the Director of the Centre Prof. Amita Pandev Bhardwai followed by Chief Guest address by Prof. P. C. Joshi (Vice Chancellor, University of Delhi, New Delhi) and Presidential address Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of our University, Prof. Ramesh Kumar Pandey and ended up by vote of thanks. The workshop was transacted through 30 distinctly designed sessions comprising of inaugural, induction, 14 demonstrations based technical sessions, 05 Question & Answer and 05 self-practice sessions, 01 each viz. online assessment, feedback, sharing of experiences and valedictory sessions. The registrations received till last date were 49 and the same continued the programme successfully. Out of 49 participants 42 were from 12 states and 07 from 02 UTs. The number of participants 12 states and were Haryana (04), Himachal Pradesh (04), Karnataka (02), Kerala (01), Maharashtra (03), Punjab (01), Rajasthan (03), Tamil Nadu (02), Tripura (01), Uttarakhand (03), Uttar Pradesh (16) & West Bengal (02) and two UTs were Delhi (06) & J&K (01). All the technical sessions were conducted under the able guidance of 10 Resource Persons (Table III) having expertise in the concerned area form various reputed institutions of the Country. The main themes covered in the workshop were- An Introduction to OERs, Development of Text & Image based e-Resources viz. Word Cloud, Concept Map & Infographics, Development of Audio & Video e-Resources as OERs and Concept of Licensing. The participants were assigned choice based 06 assignments on the basis of the themes taken-up in the technical sessions. An online test was administered where 86% of the participants scored above 60%. In order to ensure the quality of the lectures delivered from the participants' point of view an online feedback about the Resource Persons was taken in 04 categories viz. Outstanding, Very good, Good & Satisfactory and the average found was 72%, 26%, 02% & 00% in the respective categories. In addition to this, online feedback about the workshop was also taken on 10 points in five categories and the average percentage was found to be 75% Excellent, 23% Very good, 03% Good, 00% Satisfactory and 00% Unsatisfactory. In the valedictory session, the Director of the Centre welcomed the guests and presented the workshop outcomes followed by Chief Guest & Presidential address by Prof. Nageshwar Rao (Vice Chancellor, Indira Gandhi National Open University, New Delhi). The workshop ended with vote of thanks by Dean, School of Education followed by Shanti Path. After the completion of the workshop, the e-Certificate and e-Photo album were mailed to the successful participants.
