Design & Develop: Assessment Test

Brief Report

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi established under the scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission of of Education, India on **Teachers** and Teaching, Ministry Govt. organized One Week Online National Faculty Development Programme on Design & Develop: Assessment Test from **04th to 08th July, 2022** which is the 04th programme of Phase-VI. The objectives of this programme were to familiarise with the various approaches & types of assessment & their tests; to give insight in the process of designing & developing assessment tests viz. Formative, Summative, NRT, CRT, Achievement, Performance, Diagnostic, Portfolio etc.; to develop skill of preparing blue print for a test and to promote the skills related to developing various types of tests for assessment. This programme was conducted in an online mode through Google Meet platform. The inaugural session commenced with the welcome speech and backdrop note by the Director of the Centre Prof. Amita Pandey Bhardwaj followed by the Presidential Address of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of our University, Prof. Murlimanohar Pathak. The programme was transacted through 28 distinctly designed sessions comprising of inaugural, induction, 14 demonstrations based technical sessions, 05 Question & Answer and 05 self-practice sessions, 01 each viz. online assessment, feedback, sharing of experiences and valedictory sessions. The registrations received for the programme were 43 and the same continued the programme successfully. Out of 43 participants, 35 were from 14 states and 08 from 01 UT. The participants from 14 states include Andhra Pradesh (08), Assam (01), Bihar (01), Chhattisgarh (01), Goa (02), Gujarat (01), Haryana (02), Himanchal Pradesh (01), Kerala (02), Punjab (05), Tamil Nadu (02), Uttar Pradesh (01), Uttarakhand (05) & West Bengal (02) while that of one UT weas Delhi (08). All the technical sessions were conducted under the able guidance of 10 Resource Persons having expertise in the concerned area from various reputed institutions of the Country. The main themes covered in the programme were- Educational Assessment & Test, Writing of Objective Type Questions, Development of Test Blueprint, Design & Develop: Rubric Assessment, Formative Assessment Tests, Formulating Instructional Objectives, Writing of Essay & Short Answer Questions, Portfolio Assessment, Design & Develop: Criterion-Referenced Test, Norm-Referenced Test, Diagnostic Tests, Development of Class Achievement Test, Summative Assessment Tests & Performance Based Assessment Tests. The participants were assigned choice based 14 assignments based on the themes taken up in the technical sessions. An online test was administered where 55% of the participants scored above 50%. In order to ensure the quality of the lectures delivered from the participant's point of view online feedback about the Resource Persons was taken in 04 categories viz. Outstanding, Very good, Good & Satisfactory and the average found was 86%, 13%, 01% & 00% in the respective categories. In addition to this, online feedback about the programme was also taken on 10 points in five categories and the average percentage was found to be 77% Excellent, 17% Very good, 04% Good, 02% Satisfactory and 00% Unsatisfactory. In the valedictory session, the Director of the Centre welcomed the guests and presented the Programme report highlighting objectives, participation analysis, programme outcomes & feedback results followed by Chief Guest by **Prof. Mohammad Miyan** (Ex-Vice Chancellor, MANU University, Hyderabad) & Presidential address by our Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Prof. Murlimanohar Pathak. The programme ended with a vote of thanks followed by Shanti Path. E-Certificate and e-Photo album were mailed within a week to the successful participants after the completion of the programme.
