Two Weeks Online National Faculty Development Programme on

Enhancing Pedagogical Skills From 21st November to 1st December, 2022

Brief Report

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi established under the scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India organized Two Weeks Online National Faculty Development Programme on Enhancing Pedagogical Skills from 21st November to 1st December, 2022 which is the 08th programme of Phase-VI. The objectives of this programme were to acquaint with the basic components & use of various pedagogical skills viz communication, explanation, illustration, questioning, introduction etc; to give insight in the process of using various techno-pedagogical & online assessment tools; to enhance various pedagogical skills & competencies & to enhance skills & competencies of using various techno-pedagogical & online assessment tools. This programme was conducted in an online mode through Google Meet platform. The inaugural session commenced with the welcome speech and backdrop note by the Director of the Centre Prof. Amita Pandey Bhardwaj. The programme was transacted through 41 distinctly designed sessions comprising of inaugural, induction, 25 demonstrations based technical sessions, 02 participants presentation and 10 self-practice sessions, 01 each viz. online assessment, feedback, sharing of experiences and valedictory sessions. The registrations received for the programme were 35 and the same continued the programme successfully. Out of 35 participants, 25 were from 12 states and 10 from 01 UT. The participants from 12 states include Assam (01), Bihar (03), Haryana (03), Maharashtra (01), Karnataka (01), Kerala (01), Odisha (01), Rajasthan (04), Telangana (01), Uttar Pradesh (06), Uttarakhand (02) & West Bengal (01) while that of one UT was Delhi (10). All the technical sessions were conducted under the able guidance of 18 Resource Persons having expertise in the concerned area from various reputed institutions of the Country. The main themes covered in the programme were- Conducting Discussion Session, Developing Collaborative Skills through Google Drive, Learner Centric Pedagogical Approaches for Teaching & Learning, Conducting Jigsaw Strategy based Session, Brain Storming Session, Skill of Explanation, Stimulus Variation, Illustration, Questioning, Introduction & Conclusion, using e-Resources in Teaching, Reinforcement & Feedback, Steps for Conducting Flipped Teaching, Using Slido & Jamboard in Teaching, Online Interactive Pedagogical Tools, Using Padlet & Coggle

Assessment Tools, Develop & Use Google Forms and Communication Skill. The participants were assigned choice based 13 assignments based on the themes taken up in the technical sessions. An online test was administered where 32% of the participants scored above 50%. In order to ensure the quality of the lectures delivered from the participant's point of view online feedback about the Resource Persons was taken in 04 categories viz. Outstanding, Very good, Good & Satisfactory and the average found was 75%, 19%, 06% & 00% in the respective categories. In addition to this, online feedback about the programme was also taken on 10 points in five categories and the average percentage was found to be 75% Excellent, 21% Very good, 04% Good, 00% Satisfactory and 00% Unsatisfactory. In the valedictory session, the Director of the Centre welcomed the guests and presented the Programme report highlighting objectives, participation analysis, programme outcomes & feedback results followed by Special Address by Prof. R.K.S. Dhakarey (Vice Chancellor, MS Brij University, Bharatpur), Chief Guest by Prof. Roop Kishor Shastri (Vice Chancellor, Gurukul Kangri, Hardiwar) & Presidential address by our Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Prof. Murlimanohar Pathak.
