Brief Report

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi established under the scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India organized National Webinar on Indian Knowledge System & Science dated 20th December, 2022 which was the 09th programme of Phase-VI. The objectives of this webinar were to acquaint with Indian scientific Heritage & to give insight in Upanishads: Physics & Mathematics. This online webinar was conducted through Google Meet. The inaugural session commenced with the welcome speech and backdrop note by the Director of the Centre **Prof. Amita Pandey Bhardwaj**. **The registrations received till last date was 164**. The total participants participated in this seminar were 160. **Out of 160 participants 127 were from 19 states and 33 from 02 Union Territories**. The 19 states and numbers of participants were Andhra Pradesh (05), Assam (01), Bihar (12), Gujarat (02), Haryana (10), Himachal Pradesh (03), Jharkhand (03), Karnataka (02), Kerala (02), Madhya Pradesh (03), Maharashtra (02), Odisha (01), Punjab (01), Rajasthan (14), Tamil Nadu (02), Telangana (02), Uttar Pradesh (15), Uttarakhand (04) & West Bengal (04) and from 02 UTs were Delhi (31) & J&K (01). In addition to inaugural & valedictory, the webinar had 02 lectures on the theme viz. first Lecture- Indian scientific Heritage: An Overview by **Dr. T.P. Sasikumar** (Ex-Director, Academic Staff College, University of Calicut, Kerala) and second Lecture- Upanishads: Physics & Mathematics by **Swami Chidananda** (Founder, FOWAI Forum, Mumbai). In order to ensure the quality of the webinar from the participants' point of view an **online feedback about Webinar** was taken on 5 point scale ranging from **Excellent to Unsatisfactory** and the average found was **81%** in Excellent, **13%** in **Very Good**, **2% in Good**, **4% in Satisfactory & Nil in Unsatisfactory** categories. The webinar concluded ended with vote of thanks by Director of the Centre followed by Shanti Path. After the completion of the webinar, the e-Certificate was mailed to the successful participants.
