## Phase-VI, Programme-11 One Week Online National Faculty Development Programme e-Resource Development

From 13th & 17th February, 2023

## **Brief Report**

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi established under the scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India organized Two Weeks Online National Faculty Development Programme on e-Resource Development from 13th & 17th February, 2023 which is the 11<sup>th</sup> programme of Phase-VI. The objectives of this programme were to acquaint with the digital tools & softwares of developinge-resources; the various types of CC licenses; to give insight in the process of developing text, image, audio & video-based e-resources; to enhance the skills & competencies associated with developing e-resources. This programme was conducted in an online mode through Google Meet platform. The inaugural session commenced with the welcome speech and backdrop note by the Director of the Centre Prof. Amita Pandey Bhardwaj. The programme was transacted through 21 distinctly designed sessions comprising of inaugural, induction, 12 demonstrations based technical sessions and 05 self-practice sessions, 01 each viz. online assessment, feedback, sharing of experiences and valedictory sessions. The registrations received for the programme were 59 and the same continued the programme successfully. Out of 35 participants, 54 were from 12 states and 01 from 01 UT. The participants from 12 states include Andhra Pradesh (05), Assam (03), Haryana (05), Himachal Pradesh (03), Jharkhand (09), Maharashtra (04), Karnataka (01), Odisha (01), Rajasthan (12), Uttar Pradesh (04), Uttarakhand (06) & West Bengal (01) while that of one UT was Delhi (05). All the technical sessions were conducted under the able guidance of **09 Resource Persons** having expertise in the concerned area from various reputed institutions of the Country. The main themes covered in the programme were- Overview of e-Resource Development Tools, Developing Digital Mind Maps, Infographics as Image e-Resource, Text based e-Resources, Developing Videos through Screen Capturing Tools, Developing Demonstration based Videos, Developing Word Cloud & Concept Map, Developing Audio e-Resource through Audacity, Development of Animated Videos, Developing Podcast as Audio e-Resource, Developing Blog as e-Resources and Creating CC Licensing on e-Resources. An online test was administered where 63% of the participants scored above 50%. In order to ensure the quality of the lectures delivered from the participant's point of view online feedback about the Resource Persons was taken in 04 categories viz. Outstanding, Very good, Good & Satisfactory and the average found was 75%, 24%, 01%, & 00% in the respective categories. In addition to this, online feedback about the programme was also taken on 10 points in five categories and the average percentage was found to be 76% Excellent, 23% Very good, 01% Good and Nil in Satisfactory and **Unsatisfactory** categories. In the valedictory session, the Director of the Centre welcomed the guests and presented the Programme report highlighting objectives, participation analysis, programme outcomes & feedback results followed by Chief Guest by Prof. Prithvish Nag (Director, SHEPA, Varanasi) & Presidential address by our Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Prof. Murlimanohar Pathak. The programme ended with a vote of thanks followed by Shanti Path. E-Certificate and e-Photo album were mailed within a week to the successful participants after the completion of the programme.
