

Pre Ph.D Course Work

All the Ph.D. candidates admitted shall undertake the a minimum of 24 credits Ph.D. course work and complete the course work during the initial one or two semesters. In the course work in order to be eligible to undertake the research work and submit the Synopsis of the proposed Ph.D. research work for approval by the Research Degree Committee (RDC).

The Department of research is facilitating research students of the university for their six months compulsory training in the area of research methodology, review of literature and is providing light in the field of Higher Research as per the guidelines of the UGC. The medium of instructions, writing and presentation shall be Sanskrit language throughout the course of Ph.D. The credit assigned to the Ph.D. course work shall be a minimum of 06 credits and a maximum of 12 credits in conformity with the credit hour instructional requirement and shall specify content, instructional and assessment methods. The Ph.D. scholar has to obtain a minimum of 55% of marks. In the course work in order to be eligible to undertake the research work and submit the Synopsis of the proposed Ph.D. research work for approval by the Research Degree Committee (RDC).

The course structure for 26 credits Pre-Ph.D. course shall be as follows:

- Research Methodology (06 credits) covering Research methods, Nature of Research, content compilation for research etc.
- Manuscriptology and Textual Criticism (06 credits) covering Critical Editions, Fundamentals in the Critical Edition, Manuscript Collection History, Protection of Manuscripts, Bibliography etc.
- Literature Review & Research Survey (06 credits) covering History of Sanskrit Vangmaya, Research & Publication Ethics etc.
- Introducton to Computers (06 credits) covering training on computer programming for Ph.D. student.
