4.2.2 Collection of rare books, manuscripts, special reports or any other knowledge resource for library enrichment.

The library houses a vast collection of over a hundred thousand books, encompassing a wealth of knowledge in Vedic literature, scriptures, culture, society, politics, economics, law, and other disciplines. These books are available in Sanskrit, Hindi, English, and regional languages. Among these, approximately 220 books are classified as rare and many others are carefully selected and preserved. A list of these classical and non-classical books is attached.

The collection of rare manuscripts is managed by the Research and Publication Department, where their preservation also takes place. There are more than 1,400 manuscripts in the collection, including some made of Talapatra, some Kargajapatra, and others from Bhurjapatra.
